

Danube International School has around 430 students of over 50 different nationalities from Early Years (age 3) to grade 12 (age 18/19). We are an International Baccalaureate World School with the IB PYP (Primary Years Programme) in the Elementary School, MYP (Middle Years Programme) in grades 6-10 and DP (Diploma Programme) in grades 11 and 12. The language of instruction is English. Many students have lessons in their mother tongue; all students learn German, and most learn Spanish as a foreign language from grades 6-10.

In the Secondary School we offer German Language and Literature (for mother tongue German speakers or equivalent) and German Language Acquisition (for foreign language learners). We have students at all levels, from those who have just arrived in Austria to students who have been learning German most of their lives, so in the MYP German Language Acquisition is taught in ability groups from phases 1-5. In the DP we offer the German A Language and Literature and German B HL, SL and Ab Initio courses.

- All applicants need a school teaching qualification (valid in Austria or your own home country e.g. Lehramt Deutsch or for German foreign language Lehramt Deutsch/Englisch/Spanisch/Französisch + Weiterbildung DaF)
- Experience of teaching in a secondary school strongly preferred
- Experience of teaching the International Baccalaureate MYP and DP an advantage, but not essential
- Full-time position, 18 hours 40 mins per week; school day 8:00- 15:30
- The successful applicant will expect high standards from their students, whilst making learning relevant for them and inspiring them with a love of learning German
